At level 4 it is important that learners are equipped with a range of competencies across possible roles or areas of activity, as in South Africa, performing artists are usually required to fulfil

a range of functions in order to sustain their career. This includes adult learners who want to enter the sector or develop their careers in one or more of the related sub-fields.

For you to enrol on this qualification you should be in possession of:

• A National Senior Certificate or equivalent.

• A good command of English.
