People with this qualification will have an introductory level of under-standing of Applied Management, Catering Theory, Nutrition and Menu planning and Sanitation and Housekeeping.

What are the pre-requisites for the **National Certificate: N4 Hospitality and Catering Services** course?

In order for you to enrol on this qualification you should be in possession of:

- A National Certificate N3: Food Services; or a National Senior Certificate: Food Services; or a Senior Certificate and the National Introductory Certificate: N4 Food Services, or a Senior Certificate with at least one of the following: Cookery and Nutrition SG, Hotel keeping and Catering SG, Housecraft SG or Home Economics HG/SG.
- Equivalent' refers to foreign qualifications (these are qualifications that you obtained in a foreign country, and which are evaluated by SAQA to be equivalent to the university entrance qualification of South Africa).
- A good command of English.
